## A BILL

To expand Federal employee commuting options and to reduce the traffic congestion resulting from current Federal employee commuting patterns, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. FEDERAL TRANSPORTATION IN NATIONAL CAP-**  
4 **ITAL REGION.**

5 The Executive Draft on Federal Transportation in  
6 the National Capital Region which has been submitted to  
7 the Office of Management and Budget by the Secretary

1 of Transportation shall take effect on the date of enact-  
2 ment of this Act.

3 **SEC. 2. REPORT TO CONGRESS.**

4 Not later than 60 days after the date of enactment  
5 of this Act, the Secretary of Transportation shall transmit  
6 to Congress a report on the implementation of Executive  
7 Draft referred to in section 1.
