3 **SECTION 1. TEMPORARY SUSPENSION OF DUTY ON CER-**
4 **TAIN SEMI-MANUFACTURED FORMS OF GOLD.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subheading 9902.71.08 of the
6 Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is
7 amended by striking “12/31/2000” and inserting “12/31/
8 2005”.

1 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
2 subsection (a) applies with respect to goods entered, or
3 withdrawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after
4 the 15th day after the date of enactment of this Act.
