A BILL

To provide each Member of the Senate with a mail allowance sufficient to permit at least 1 mailing per fiscal year to each postal address in each county in the State of that Member where the Member holds and personally attends a town meeting.

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. MAIL ALLOWANCE FOR SENATORS.**

4 Section 506 of the Supplemental Appropriations Act,
5 1973 (2 U.S.C. 58) is amended by inserting after sub-
6 section (b) the following:

1 “(c) In addition to the funds provided for in sub-
2 section (b), the amount available to a Member under sub-
3 section (b)(3)(A)(iii) shall include an additional amount
4 sufficient to pay the expenses that would be incurred mail-
5 ing 1 letter to each postal address in each county in the
6 State of that Member where the Member holds and per-
7 sonally attends a town meeting (not to exceed 1 town
8 meeting per county per year).”.
