1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Breast Cancer Re-
5 search Stamp Reauthorization Act of 2000”.

6 **SEC. 2. BREAST CANCER STAMP EXTENSION.**

7 Section 414(g) of title 39, United States Code, is
8 amended by striking “2-year” and inserting “4-year”.
