## A BILL

To extend the deadline for commencement of construction of a hydroelectric project in the State of Pennsylvania.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF DEADLINE AND REINSTATE-**  
4 **MENT OF LICENSE.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding the time period  
6 specified in section 13 of the Federal Power Act (16  
7 U.S.C. 806) that would otherwise apply to the Federal En-  
8 ergy Regulatory Commission project numbered 7041, the  
9 Commission shall, at the request of the licensee for the

1 project, extend the period required for commencement of  
2 construction of the project until December 31, 2001.

3 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—Subsection (a) takes effect  
4 on the expiration of the period required for commencement  
5 of construction of the project described in subsection (a).

6 (c) REINSTATEMENT OF EXPIRED LICENSE.—If the  
7 license for the project described in subsection (a) has ex-  
8 pired before the date of enactment of this Act, the Com-  
9 mission shall reinstate the license effective as of the date  
10 of its expiration and extend the time required for com-  
11 mencement of construction as provided in subsection (a).
