A BILL

For the relief of Sergio Lozano, Fauricio Lozano and Ana Lozano.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PERMANENT RESIDENT STATUS FOR SERGIO**
4 **LOZANO, FAURICIO LOZANO AND ANA**
5 **LOZANO.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding subsections (a)
7 and (b) of section 201 of the Immigration and Nationality
8 Act, Sergio Lozano, Fauricio Lozano and Ana Lozano
9 shall be eligible for issuance of an immigrant visa or for
10 adjustment of status to that of an alien lawfully admitted
11 for permanent residence upon filing an application for

1 issuance of an immigrant visa under section 204 of such
2 Act or for adjustment of status to lawful permanent resi-
3 dent.

4 (b) ADJUSTMENT OF STATUS.—If Sergio Lozano,
5 Fauricio Lozano and Ana Lozano enter the United States
6 before the filing deadline specified in subsection (c), they
7 shall be considered to have entered and remained lawfully
8 and shall, if otherwise eligible, be eligible for adjustment
9 of status under section 245 of the Immigration and Na-
10 tionality Act as of the date of the enactment of this Act.

11 (c) DEADLINE FOR APPLICATION AND PAYMENT OF
12 FEES.—Subsections (a) and (b) shall apply only if the ap-
13 plications for issuance of immigrant visas or the applica-
14 tions for adjustment of status are filed with appropriate
15 fees within 2 years after the date of the enactment of this
16 Act.

17 (d) REDUCTION OF IMMIGRANT VISA NUMBER.—
18 Upon the granting of an immigrant visa or permanent resi-
19 dence to Sergio Lozano, Fauricio Lozano and Ana
20 Lozano, the Secretary of State shall instruct the proper
21 officer to reduce by three, during the current or next fol-
22 lowing fiscal year, the total number of immigrant visas
23 that are made available to natives of the country of the
24 aliens' birth under section 203(a) of the Immigration and
25 Nationality Act or, if applicable, the total number of immi-

1 grant visas that are made available to natives of the coun-
2 try of the aliens' birth under section 202(e) of such Act.
