A BILL

To provide for a temporary Federal district judgeship for the southern district of Indiana.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. TEMPORARY JUDGESHIP FOR THE SOUTHERN**

4 **DISTRICT OF INDIANA.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—The President shall appoint, by
6 and with the advice and consent of the Senate, 1 addi-
7 tional district judge for the southern district of Indiana.

8 (b) FIRST VACANCY NOT FILLED.—The first va-
9 cancy in the office of district judge in the southern district
10 of Indiana, occurring 7 years or more after the confirma-

1 tion date of the judge named to fill the temporary judge-
2 ship created under subsection (a), shall not be filled.

3 (c) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—There
4 are authorized to be appropriated such sums as may be
5 necessary to carry out the provisions of this Act, including
6 such sums as may be necessary to provide appropriate
7 space and facilities for the judicial position created by this
8 Act.
