A BILL

To provide for an investigation and audit at the Department of Education.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. INVESTIGATION AND AUDIT.**

4 Not later than 6 months after the date of the enact-
5 ment of this Act, the Comptroller General of the United
6 States shall—

7 (1) conduct and complete an investigation for
8 fraud at the Department of Education, including an
9 audit of any financial statements, with respect to ac-
10 counts at the Department of Education that the

1 Comptroller General determines particularly suscep-
2 tible to waste, fraud, or abuse; and

3 (2) submit a report setting forth the results of
4 the investigation and audit to the Committee on
5 Education and the Workforce of the House of Rep-
6 resentatives and the Committee on Health, Edu-
7 cation, Labor, and Pensions of the Senate.
