3 **SECTION 1. DESIGNATION OF FLOYD H. FLAKE FEDERAL**
4 **BUILDING.**

5 The Federal building located at 158–15 Liberty Ave-
6 nue in Jamaica, Queens, New York, shall be known and
7 designated as the “Floyd H. Flake Federal Building”.

1 **SEC. 2. REFERENCES.**

2 Any reference in a law, map, regulation, document,
3 paper, or other record of the United States to the Federal
4 building referred to in section 1 shall be deemed to be
5 a reference to the Floyd H. Flake Federal Building.
