To make technical amendments concerning contracts affecting certain Indian tribes in Oklahoma, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. TECHNICAL CORRECTIONS CONCERNING THE**
4 **FIVE CIVILIZED TRIBES OF OKLAHOMA.**

5 (a) INDIAN SELF-DETERMINATION ACT.—Section
6 1(b)(15)(A) of the model agreement set forth in section
7 108(c) of the Indian Self-Determination Act (25 U.S.C.
8 4501(c)) is amended—

9 (1) by striking “and section 16” and inserting
10 “, section 16”; and

1 (2) by striking “shall not” and inserting “and
2 the Act of July 3, 1952 (25 U.S.C. 82a), shall not”.

3 (b) INDIAN SELF-DETERMINATION AND EDUCATION
4 ASSISTANCE ACT.—Section 403(h)(2) of the Indian Self-
5 Determination and Education Assistance Act (25 U.S.C.
6 458cc(h)(2)) is amended—

7 (1) by striking “and section” and inserting
8 “section”; and

9 (2) by striking “shall not” and inserting “and
10 the Act of July 3, 1952 (25 U.S.C. 82a), shall not”.

11 (c) REPEALS.—The following provisions of law are
12 repealed:

13 (1) Section 2106 of the Revised Statutes (25
14 U.S.C. 84).

15 (2) Sections 438 and 439 of title 18, United
16 States Code.
