A BILL

For the relief of Kerantha Poole-Christian.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. CLASSIFICATION AS A CHILD UNDER THE IMMI-**
4 **GRATION AND NATIONALITY ACT.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—In the administration of the Im-
6 migration and Nationality Act, Kerantha Poole-Christian
7 shall be classified as a child within the meaning of section
8 101(b)(1)(E) of such Act, upon approval of a petition filed
9 on her behalf by Clifton or Linette Christian, citizens of
10 the United States, pursuant to section 204 of such Act.

1 (b) LIMITATION.—No natural parent, brother, or sis-
2 ter, if any, of Kerantha Poole-Christian shall, by virtue
3 of such relationship, be accorded any right, privilege, or
4 status under the Immigration and Nationality Act.
