To amend the Cache La Poudre River Corridor Act to make technical corrections, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. CACHE LA POUFRE RIVER CORRIDOR.**

4 Section 103(b) of the Cache La Poudre River Cor-
5 ridor Act (16 U.S.C. 461 note, Public Law 104–323) is
6 amended in paragraphs (12) through (19), by striking
7 “LARIMER COUNTY” each place it appears and inserting
8 “WELD COUNTY”.

1 **SEC. 2. CACHE LA POUFRE RIVER CORRIDOR COMMISSION.**

2 Section 104 of the Cache La Poudre River Corridor
3 Act (16 U.S.C. 461 note, Public Law 104–323) is
4 amended—

5 (1) by striking subsection (a) and inserting the
6 following:

7 “(a) IN GENERAL.—There is established a commis-
8 sion to be known as the ‘Cache La Poudre Corridor Com-
9 mission’ that shall—

10 “(1) administer the Corridor; and

11 “(2) provide certain services under this Act.”;

12 and

13 (2) in subsection (b)(1)(A)(v)(III), by striking
14 “within” and inserting “in the vicinity of”.
