## A BILL

To authorize the Secretary of the Interior to transfer administrative jurisdiction over land within the boundaries of the Home of Franklin D. Roosevelt National Historic Site to the Archivist of the United States for the construction of a visitor center.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. VISITOR CENTER FOR HOME OF FRANKLIN D.**

4                               **ROOSEVELT NATIONAL HISTORIC SITE.**

5       (a) **TRANSFER OF ADMINISTRATIVE JURISDIC-**  
6 **TION.**—The Secretary of the Interior may transfer to the  
7 Archivist of the United States administrative jurisdiction

1 over land located in the Home of Franklin D. Roosevelt  
2 National Historic Site in Hyde Park, New York.

3 (b) VISITOR CENTER.—On the land transferred  
4 under subsection (a), the Archivist shall construct a visitor  
5 center facility to serve the Home of Franklin D. Roosevelt  
6 National Historic Site and the Franklin D. Roosevelt  
7 Presidential Library.

8 (c) CONDITIONS OF TRANSFER.—

9 (1) PROTECTION OF THE SITE.—Any transfer  
10 under subsection (a) shall be subject to an agree-  
11 ment between the Secretary and the Archivist that  
12 includes provisions for the protection of the Home of  
13 Franklin D. Roosevelt National Historic Site and for  
14 the joint use of the visitor center facility by the Sec-  
15 retary and the Archivist.

16 (2) DISCONTINUANCE OF USE BY THE ARCHI-  
17 VIST.—If the Archivist determines to discontinue use  
18 of land transferred under subsection (a), the Archi-  
19 vist shall retransfer administrative jurisdiction over  
20 the land to the Secretary.

21 (d) LAND DESCRIPTION.—The land referred to in  
22 subsection (a) shall consist of not more than 1 acre of  
23 land, as agreed to by the Secretary and the Archivist and

1 more particularly described in the agreement under sub-  
2 section (c)(1).
