Mr. LOTT submitted the following concurrent resolution; which was considered and agreed to

CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Providing for a conditional adjournment or recess of the Senate and a conditional adjournment of the House of Representatives.

1 *Resolved by the Senate (the House of Representatives*
2 *concurring)*, That when the Senate recesses or adjourns
3 at the close of business on Wednesday, November 1, 2000,
4 or Thursday, November 2, 2000, on a motion offered pur-
5 suant to this concurrent resolution by its Majority Leader
6 or his designee, it stand recessed or adjourned until noon
7 on Tuesday, November 14, 2000, or until such time on
8 that day as may be specified by its Majority Leader or
9 his designee in the motion to recess or adjourn, or until
10 noon on the second day after Members are notified to reas-

1 semble pursuant to section 2 of this concurrent resolution,
2 whichever occurs first; and that when the House adjourns
3 on the legislative day of Wednesday, November 1, 2000,
4 or Thursday, November 2, 2000, on a motion offered pur-
5 suant to this concurrent resolution by its Majority Leader
6 or his designee, it stand adjourned until noon on Monday,
7 November 13, 2000, at 2 p.m., or until noon on the second
8 day after Members are notified to reassemble pursuant to
9 section 2 of this concurrent resolution, whichever occurs
10 first.

11 SEC. 2. The Majority Leader of the Senate and the
12 Speaker of the House, acting jointly after consultation
13 with the Minority Leader of the Senate and the Minority
14 Leader of the House, shall notify the Members of the Sen-
15 ate and House, respectively, to reassemble whenever, in
16 their opinion, the public interest shall warrant it.
