Mr. LOTT submitted the following concurrent resolution; which was considered and agreed to

CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Providing for a conditional adjournment or recess of the Senate and a conditional adjournment of the House of Representatives.

1 *Resolved by the Senate (the House of Representatives*
2 *concurring)*, That when the Senate recesses or adjourns
3 at the close of business on Thursday, July 1, 1999, Fri-
4 day, July 2, 1999, or Saturday, July 3, 1999, on a motion
5 offered pursuant to this concurrent resolution by its Ma-
6 jority Leader or his designee, it stand recessed or ad-
7 journed until noon on Monday, July 12, 1999, or until
8 such time on that day as may be specified by its Majority
9 Leader or his designee in the motion to recess or adjourn,
10 or until noon on the second day after Members are notified

1 to reassemble pursuant to section 2 of this concurrent res-
2 olution, whichever occurs first; and that when the House
3 adjourns on the legislative day of Thursday, July 1, 1999,
4 or Friday, July 2, 1999, on a motion offered pursuant
5 to this concurrent resolution by its Majority Leader or his
6 designee, it stand adjourned until 12:30 p.m. on Monday,
7 July 12, 1999, for morning-hour debate, or until noon on
8 the second day after Members are notified to reassemble
9 pursuant to section 2 of this concurrent resolution, which-
10 ever occurs first.

11 SEC. 2. The Majority Leader of the Senate and the
12 Speaker of the House, acting jointly after consultation
13 with the Minority Leader of the Senate and the Minority
14 Leader of the House, shall notify the Members of the Sen-
15 ate and House, respectively, to reassemble whenever, in
16 their opinion, the public interest shall warrant it.

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
