

CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

1 *Resolved by the Senate (the House of Representatives*
2 *concurring)*, That when the Senate recesses or adjourns
3 at the close of business on Thursday, July 1, 1999, Fri-
4 day, July 2, 1999, or Saturday, July 3, 1999, on a motion
5 offered pursuant to this concurrent resolution by its Ma-
6 jority Leader or his designee, it stand recessed or ad-
7 journed until noon on Monday, July 12, 1999, or until
8 such time on that day as may be specified by its Majority
9 Leader or his designee in the motion to recess or adjourn,
10 or until noon on the second day after Members are notified
11 to reassemble pursuant to section 2 of this concurrent res-
12 olution, whichever occurs first; and that when the House
13 adjourns on the legislative day of Thursday, July 1, 1999,
14 or Friday, July 2, 1999, on a motion offered pursuant
15 to this concurrent resolution by its Majority Leader or his
16 designee, it stand adjourned until 12:30 p.m. on Monday,
17 July 12, 1999, for morning-hour debate, or until noon on
18 the second day after Members are notified to reassemble

1 pursuant to section 2 of this concurrent resolution, which-
2 ever occurs first.

3 SEC. 2. The Majority Leader of the Senate and the
4 Speaker of the House, acting jointly after consultation
5 with the Minority Leader of the Senate and the Minority
6 Leader of the House, shall notify the Members of the Sen-
7 ate and House, respectively, to reassemble whenever, in
8 their opinion, the public interest shall warrant it.
