Mr. LOTT submitted the following concurrent resolution; which was considered and agreed to

CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Providing for a conditional adjournment or recess of the Senate and a conditional adjournment of the House of Representatives.

1 *Resolved by the Senate (the House of Representatives*
2 *concurring)*, That when the Senate recesses or adjourns
3 at the close of business on Thursday, February 10, 2000,
4 or Friday, February 11, 2000, on a motion offered pursu-
5 ant to this concurrent resolution by its Majority Leader
6 or his designee, it stand recessed or adjourned until noon
7 on Tuesday, February 22, 2000, or until such time on that
8 day as may be specified by its Majority Leader or his des-
9 ignee in the motion to recess or adjourn, or until noon
10 on the second day after Members are notified to reassem-

1 ble pursuant to section 2 of this concurrent resolution,
2 whichever occurs first; and that when the House adjourns
3 on the legislative day of Wednesday, February 16, 2000,
4 Thursday, February 17, 2000, or Friday, February 18,
5 2000, on a motion offered pursuant to this concurrent res-
6 olution by its Majority Leader or his designee, it stand
7 adjourned until 12:30 p.m. on Tuesday, February 29,
8 2000, for morning-hour debate, or until noon on the sec-
9 ond day after Members are notified to reassemble pursu-
10 ant to section 2 of this concurrent resolution, whichever
11 occurs first.

12 SEC. 2. The Majority Leader of the Senate and the
13 Speaker of the House, acting jointly after consultation
14 with the Minority Leader of the Senate and the Minority
15 Leader of the House, shall notify the Members of the Sen-
16 ate and House, respectively, to reassemble whenever, in
17 their opinion, the public interest shall warrant it.
