mittee on Rules and Administration

JOINT RESOLUTION

Providing for the appointment of Sheila E. Widnall as a
citizen regent of the Board of Regents of the Smithso-
nian Institution.

1 *Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives*
2 *of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That, in accordance with section 5581 of the Revised Stat-
4 utes of the United States (20 U.S.C. 43), the vacancy on
5 the Board of Regents of the Smithsonian Institution, in
6 the class other than Members of Congress, occurring by
7 reason of the expiration of the term of Frank A. Shrontz
8 of Washington on May 4, 2000, is filled by the appoint-
9 ment of Sheila E. Widnall of Massachusetts. The appoint-

1 ment is for a term of 6 years and shall take effect on
2 May 5, 2000.
