2 **SECTION 1. REFERRAL.**

3 S. 1698 entitled “A bill for the relief of D.W.
4 Jacobson, Ronald Karkala, and Paul Bjorgen of Grand
5 Rapids, Minnesota” now pending in the Senate, together
6 with all the accompanying papers, is referred to the chief
7 judge of the United States Court of Federal Claims.

1 **SEC. 2. PROCEEDING AND REPORT.**

2 The chief judge shall—

3 (1) proceed according to the provisions of sec-
4 tions 1492 and 2509 of title 28, United States Code;
5 and

6 (2) report back to the Senate, at the earliest
7 practicable date, providing—

8 (A) such findings of fact and conclusions
9 that are sufficient to inform the Congress of the
10 nature, extent, and character of the claim for
11 compensation referred to in such bill as a legal
12 or equitable claim against the United States or
13 a gratuity; and

14 (B) the amount, if any, legally or equitably
15 due from the United States to D.W. Jacobson,
16 Ronald Karkala, and Paul Bjorgen of Grand
17 Rapids, Minnesota.
