2       **SECTION 1. REFERRAL.**

3       S. 1456 entitled “A bill for the relief of Rocco A.  
4 Trecosta of Fort Lauderdale, Florida” now pending in the  
5 Senate, together with all the accompanying papers, is re-  
6 ferred to the chief judge of the United States Court of  
7 Federal Claims.

1 **SEC. 2. PROCEEDING AND REPORT.**

2 The chief judge shall—

3 (1) proceed according to the provisions of sec-  
4 tions 1492 and 2509 of title 28, United States Code;  
5 and

6 (2) report back to the Senate, at the earliest  
7 practicable date, providing—

8 (A) such findings of fact and conclusions  
9 that are sufficient to inform the Congress of the  
10 nature, extent, and character of the claim for  
11 compensation referred to in such bill as a legal  
12 or equitable claim against the United States or  
13 a gratuity; and

14 (B) the amount, if any, legally or equitably  
15 due from the United States to Rocco A.  
16 Trecoستا of Fort Lauderdale, Florida.
