RESOLUTION

Relative to the Death of Murray Zweben, Parliamentarian
Emeritus of the United States Senate.

Whereas Murray Zweben served the Senate with honor and
distinction as its third Parliamentarian from 1974 to
1981;

Whereas Murray Zweben was Assistant Senate Parliamen-
tarian from 1963 to 1974;

Whereas Murray Zweben served the Senate for more than 20
years;

Whereas Murray Zweben performed his Senate duties in an
impartial and professional manner;

Whereas Murray Zweben was honored by the Senate with the
title Parliamentarian Emeritus; and

Whereas Murray Zweben served his country as an officer in the United States Navy from 1953 to 1956: Now, therefore, be it

1 *Resolved*, That the Senate has heard with profound
2 sorrow and deep regret the announcement of the death
3 of the Honorable Murray Zweben, Parliamentarian Emer-
4 itus of the United States Senate; be it further

5 *Resolved*, That the Secretary of the Senate commu-
6 nicate these resolutions to the House of Representatives
7 and transmit an enrolled copy thereof to the family of the
8 deceased; and be it further

9 *Resolved*, That when the Senate adjourns today, it
10 stand adjourned as a further mark of respect to the mem-
11 ory of the Honorable Murray Zweben.
