2 **SECTION 1. INCREASE IN AUTHORIZATION FOR EXPENDI-**
3 **TURES RELATING TO FOREIGN INTER-**
4 **CHANGES.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—The first section of Senate Reso-
6 lution 247, Eighty-seventh Congress, agreed to February
7 7, 1962 (as amended by section 3(c) of Senate Resolution

1 281, Ninety-sixth Congress, agreed to March 11, 1980)
2 is amended by striking “\$25,000” and inserting
3 “\$30,000”.

4 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
5 subsection (a) shall take effect on the date on which this
6 resolution is agreed to and shall apply to fiscal year 2000
7 and each fiscal year thereafter.
