CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Providing for the sine die adjournment of the first session of the One Hundred Seventh Congress.

1 *Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate*
2 *concurring)*, That when the House adjourns on the legisla-
3 tive day of Thursday, December 20, 2001, or Friday, De-
4 cember 21, 2001, on a motion offered pursuant to this
5 concurrent resolution by its Majority Leader or his des-
6 ignee, it stand adjourned sine die, or until Members are
7 notified to reassemble pursuant to section 2 of this concur-
8 rent resolution, whichever occurs first; and that when the
9 Senate adjourns at the close of business on Thursday, De-
10 cember 20, 2001, or Friday, December 21, 2001, on a

1 motion offered pursuant to this concurrent resolution by
2 its Majority Leader or his designee, it stand adjourned
3 sine die, or until Members are notified to reassemble pur-
4 suant to section 2 of this concurrent resolution, whichever
5 occurs first.

6 SEC. 2. The Speaker of the House and the Majority
7 Leader of the Senate, acting jointly after consultation with
8 the Minority Leader of the House and the Minority Lead-
9 er of the Senate, shall notify the Members of the House
10 and the Senate, respectively, to reassemble at such place
11 and time as they may designate whenever, in their opinion,
12 the public interest shall warrant it.
