## CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Expressing the sense of Congress regarding the establishment by the Hyundai Motor Company of its first automotive manufacturing facility in the United States.

Whereas on April 1, 2002, the Hyundai Motor Company decided to locate an automotive manufacturing facility in Montgomery, Alabama;

Whereas this automotive manufacturing plant will be Hyundai's first facility in the United States;

Whereas the expected investment in the United States economy from the new Montgomery Hyundai plant is more than \$1,000,000,000;

Whereas Hyundai's Montgomery, Alabama, facility will employ an estimated 2,000 primary workers and create more than 4,000 additional jobs in related industries; and

Whereas to date trade relations between the United States and the Republic of Korea with respect to automotive manufacturing have resulted in an approximate \$6,000,000,000 deficit with Korea: Now, therefore, be it

1        *Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate*  
 2 *concurring), That Congress—*

3            (1) commends the Hyundai Motor Company for  
 4        its decision to locate its first United States auto-  
 5        motive manufacturing facility in Montgomery, Ala-  
 6        bama;

7            (2) recognizes that the new facility in Mont-  
 8        gomery, Alabama, will result in the gainful employ-  
 9        ment of several thousand Americans, as well as fos-  
 10       ter economic growth in the surrounding area; and

11           (3) recognizes that Hyundai's decision to locate  
 12        this facility in Alabama is a positive step in improv-  
 13        ing trade relations between the United States and  
 14        the Republic of Korea.
