## JOINT RESOLUTION

Making further continuing appropriations for the fiscal year  
2002, and for other purposes.

1       *Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives*  
2       *of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*  
3       That Public Law 107–44 is amended by striking “October  
4       16, 2001” in section 107(c) and inserting in lieu thereof

1 “October 23, 2001”; by adding the following before the  
2 semicolon in section 101(b)(1) “: *Provided*, That the rate  
3 for operations of the Defense Health Program may exceed  
4 the current rate as may be necessary to fund a pro rata  
5 share of the program expansion authorized by section  
6 712(a) of the Floyd D. Spence National Defense Author-  
7 ization Act for Fiscal Year 2001 (Public Law 106–398)”;  
8 by striking section 115 and adding the following:

9       “SEC. 115. Notwithstanding the dates specified in  
10 section 7 of the Export-Import Bank Act of 1945 (12  
11 U.S.C. 635f) and section 1(c) of Public Law 103–428, the  
12 Export-Import Bank of the United States shall continue  
13 to exercise its functions in connection with and in further-  
14 ance of its objects and purposes through the date specified  
15 in section 107(c) of this joint resolution.”; and adding the  
16 following new section:

17       “SEC. 123. Notwithstanding section 107, funds shall  
18 be available and obligations for mandatory payments due  
19 on or about November 1, 2001, may continue to be  
20 made.”.

Passed the House of Representatives October 11,  
2001.
