3 **SECTION 1. COVERAGE FOR CROP LOSSES FROM PLANT**
4 **DISEASE UNDER CROP INSURANCE AND NON-**
5 **INSURED CROP ASSISTANCE PROGRAMS.**

6 (a) CROP INSURANCE PROGRAM.—Section 508 of the
7 Federal Crop Insurance Act (7 U.S.C. 1508) is amended

1 in subsections (a)(1) and (b)(1) by inserting “plant dis-
2 ease,” after “flood,”.

3 (b) NONINSURED CROP ASSISTANCE PROGRAM.—
4 Section 196(a)(3) of the Federal Agriculture Improvement
5 and Reform Act of 1996 (7 U.S.C. 7333(a)(3)) is amend-
6 ed by inserting “plant disease,” after “flood,”.

7 **SEC. 2. AUTHORITY TO MAKE EMERGENCY DISASTER**
8 **LOANS FOR FARMING OPERATIONS SUBSTAN-**
9 **TIALLY AFFECTED BY A PLANT DISEASE.**

10 Section 321(a) of the Consolidated Farm and Rural
11 Development Act (7 U.S.C. 1961(a)) is amended by in-
12 serting “or plant disease” after “natural disaster” each
13 place such term appears.
