1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PROHIBITION OF EXPENDITURE OF FUNDS FOR**
4 **MID-ATLANTIC OIL AND GAS LEASE SALE.**

5 The Secretary of the Interior shall not expend any
6 funds for the preparation of, or conduct of, preleasing and
7 leasing activities (including calls for information, tract se-
8 lection, notices of sale, receipt of bids, and award of
9 leases) with respect to an oil and gas lease sale on any
10 lands of the outer Continental Shelf between the seaward

- 2 Island and the seaward boundary between the States of
- 3 North Carolina and South Carolina.
