## A BILL

To allow States to spend certain funds to establish and maintain peer mediation programs.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. GOVERNOR'S PROGRAMS.**

4       Section 4114(c) of the Elementary and Secondary  
5       Education Act of 1965 (20 U.S.C. 7114) is amended—

6               (1) by striking “and” at the end of paragraph  
7       (11);

8               (2) by redesignating paragraph (12) as (13);

9       and

1           (3) by inserting after paragraph (11) the fol-  
2           lowing:

3           “(12) establishing and maintaining peer medi-  
4           ation programs that include educating and training  
5           peer mediators and a designated faculty supervisor  
6           and purchasing necessary materials to facilitate  
7           training and the mediation process; and”.
