**AN ACT**

To designate the facility of the United States Postal Service located at 419 Rutherford Avenue, N.E., in Roanoke, Virginia, as the “M. Caldwell Butler Post Office Building”.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. DESIGNATION.**

4 The facility of the United States Postal Service lo-  
5 cated at 419 Rutherford Avenue, N.E., in Roanoke, Vir-  
6 ginia, shall be known and designated as the “M. Caldwell  
7 Butler Post Office Building”.

1 **SEC. 2. REFERENCES.**

2       Any reference in a law, map, regulation, document,  
3 paper, or other record of the United States to the facility  
4 referred to in section 1 shall be deemed to be a reference  
5 to the “M. Caldwell Butler Post Office Building”.
