Mr. PETERSON of Minnesota introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure

A BILL

To amend title 49, United States Code, to require the National Transportation Safety Board to investigate all fatal railroad grade crossing accidents.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Fatal Grade Crossing
5 Accident Investigations Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. GRADE CROSSING ACCIDENTS.**

7 That section 1131(a)(1) of title 49, United States
8 Code, is amended:

1 (1) in subparagraph (B) by striking “including
2 a railroad grade crossing accident”; and

3 (2) in subparagraph (C) by inserting “, includ-
4 ing a railroad grade crossing accident,” after “rail-
5 road accident”.
