## A BILL

To amend the Clayton Act with respect to the exemptions from the notification requirements of section 7A of such Act.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Passive Investor Regu-  
5 latory Relief Act of 2001”.

6 **SEC. 2. AMENDMENT.**

7 Section 7A(c)(9) of the Clayton Act (15 U.S.C.  
8 18a(c)(9)) is amended by striking “, solely for the purpose  
9 of investment,”.

1 **SEC. 3. EFFECTIVE DATE; APPLICATION OF AMENDMENT.**

2 (a) **EFFECTIVE DATE.**—This Act and the amend-  
3 ment made by this Act shall take effect on the 1st day  
4 of the 1st month that begins more than 15 days after the  
5 date of the enactment of this Act.

6 (b) **APPLICATION OF AMENDMENT.**—The amendment  
7 made by this Act shall not apply with respect to conduct  
8 occurring before the effective date of this Act.
