## AN ACT

To designate the facility of the United States Postal Service located in Harlem, Montana, as the “Francis Bardanouve United States Post Office Building”.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. DESIGNATION.**

2       The facility of the United States Postal Service lo-  
3 cated at 216 2nd Street, S.W. in Harlem, Montana, shall  
4 be designated and known as the “Francis Bardanouve  
5 United States Post Office Building”.

6 **SEC. 2. REFERENCES.**

7       Any reference in a law, map, regulation, document,  
8 paper, or other record of the United States to the United  
9 State Post Office referred to in section 1 shall be deemed  
10 to be a reference to the “Francis Bardanouve United  
11 States Post Office Building”.
