**AN ACT**

To designate the facility of the United States Postal Service located in Harlem, Montana, as the “Francis Bardanouve United States Post Office Building”.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. DESIGNATION.**

4 The facility of the United States Postal Service lo-  
5 cated at 216 2nd Street, S.W. in Harlem, Montana, shall  
6 be designated and known as the “Francis Bardanouve  
7 United States Post Office Building”.

1 **SEC. 2. REFERENCES.**

2 Any reference in a law, map, regulation, document,  
3 paper, or other record of the United States to the United  
4 State Post Office referred to in section 1 shall be deemed  
5 to be a reference to the “Francis Bardanouve United  
6 States Post Office Building”.
