A BILL

To redesignate the facility of the United States Postal Service located at 89 River Street in Hoboken, New Jersey, as the “Frank Sinatra Post Office Building”.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. FRANK SINATRA POST OFFICE BUILDING.**

4 (a) REDESIGNATION.—The facility of the United
5 States Postal Service located at 89 River Street in Hobo-
6 ken, New Jersey, and known as the Hoboken Main Post
7 Office, shall be known and designated as the “Frank Si-
8 natra Post Office Building”.

1 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-
2 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United
3 States to the facility referred to in subsection (a) shall
4 be deemed to be a reference to the Frank Sinatra Post
5 Office Building.
