## A BILL

To amend title 18, United States Code, to eliminate the securities fraud exception from the civil remedy for racketeering violations.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Securities Fraud Pre-  
5 vention Act of 2002”.

1 **SEC. 2. ELIMINATION OF SECURITIES FRAUD EXCEPTION**  
2 **FROM CIVIL RACKETEERING REMEDIES.**

3 Section 1964(c) of title 18, United States Code, is  
4 amended by striking “, except that no person may rely”  
5 and all that follows through “conviction becomes final”.
