Mr. HINCHAY introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Ways and Means

A BILL

To amend the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 to allow a \$1,000 refundable credit for individuals who are active members of volunteer firefighting and emergency medical service organizations.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. REFUNDABLE CREDIT FOR ACTIVE MEMBERS**
4 **OF VOLUNTEER FIREFIGHTING AND EMER-**
5 **GENCY MEDICAL SERVICE ORGANIZATIONS.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subpart C of part IV of sub-
7 chapter A of chapter 1 of the Internal Revenue Code of
8 1986 (relating to refundable credits) is amended by redess-

1 ignating section 35 as section 36 and by inserting after
2 section 34 the following new section:

3 **“SEC. 35. ACTIVE MEMBERS OF VOLUNTEER FIREFIGHTING**
4 **AND EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICE ORGA-**
5 **NIZATIONS.**

6 “(a) IN GENERAL.—In the case of an individual who
7 at any time during the taxable year is an active member
8 of a qualified volunteer fire department (as defined in sec-
9 tion 150(e)), there shall be allowed as a credit against the
10 tax imposed by this subtitle the amount of \$1,000.

11 “(b) PART-YEAR ACTIVE MEMBERS.—In the case of
12 an individual who is such an active member for only a
13 portion of a taxable year, the amount of the credit under
14 subsection (a) for such taxable year shall be an amount
15 which bears the same ratio to \$1,000 as such portion
16 bears to the entire taxable year.”

17 (b) CONFORMING AMENDMENTS.—

18 (1) Paragraph (2) of section 1324(b) of title
19 31, United States Code, is amended by inserting be-
20 fore the period “, or from section 35 of such Code”.

21 (2) The table of sections for subpart C of part
22 IV of subchapter A of chapter 1 of such Code is
23 amended by striking the last item and inserting the
24 following new items:

“Sec. 35. Active members of volunteer firefighting and emergency
medical service organizations.

“Sec. 36. Overpayments of tax.”

1 (c) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by
2 this section shall apply to taxable years beginning after
3 the date of the enactment of this Act.

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
