6       (a) HOUSING EDUCATION AND ORGANIZATIONAL

7       SUPPORT.—Section 233(d) of the Cranston-Gonzalez Na-

1 tional Affordable Housing Act (42 U.S.C. 12773(d)) is  
2 amended—

3 (1) by striking “may not—” and all that fol-  
4 lows through “(1)” and inserting “may not”; and

5 (2) by striking “; or” at the end of paragraph  
6 (1) and all that follows through the end of para-  
7 graph (2) and inserting a period.

8 (b) OTHER SUPPORT FOR STATE AND LOCAL HOUS-  
9 ING STRATEGIES.—The first sentence of section 243(b) of  
10 the Cranston-Gonzalez National Affordable Housing Act  
11 (42 U.S.C. 12783(b)) is amended by striking “and shall  
12 provide not more than 20 percent of the operating budget  
13 of the contracting organization in any one year”.

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
