3 **SECTION 1. VINCENT FAULISE POST OFFICE BUILDING.**

4 (a) DESIGNATION.—The facility of the United States
5 Postal Service located at 66 South Broad Street in
6 Pawcatuck, Connecticut, shall be known and designated
7 as the “Vincent F. Faulise Post Office Building”.

1 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-
2 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United
3 States to the facility referred to in subsection (a) shall
4 be deemed to be a reference to the Vincent F. Faulise Post
5 Office Building.
