## A BILL

To suspend temporarily the duty on acrylic fiber tow.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. ACRYLIC FIBER TOW.**

4       (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of  
5 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is  
6 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following  
7 new heading:

“	9902.55.01	Acrylic fiber tow (polyacrylonitrile tow) consisting of 6 sub bundles crimped together, each containing 45,000 filaments and 2%–8% water, such acrylic fiber containing a minimum of 92% acrylonitrile, not more than 0.1% zinc and average filament denier of either 1.35 +/- 0.08 or 1.2 +/- .08 (provided for in sub-heading 5501.30.00) .....	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/2007	”.

1           (b) **EFFECTIVE DATE.**—The amendment made by  
2 subsection (a) applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from  
3 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after  
4 the date of the enactment of this Act.
