Mr. STUPAK (for himself and Mr. LATOURETTE) introduced the following bill;
which was referred to the Committee on Armed Services

A BILL

To prohibit the Secretary of Defense from purchasing certain steel or equipment, products, or systems made with steel that is not melted and poured in the United States.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PROHIBITION AGAINST PURCHASING CERTAIN**
4 **STEEL NOT MELTED AND Poured IN THE**
5 **UNITED STATES.**

6 (a) PROHIBITION.—The Secretary of Defense may
7 not purchase—

8 (1) steel, or

1 (2) equipment, products, or systems that are
2 necessary to national security or national defense
3 and that are made with steel,
4 that is not melted and poured in the United States except
5 in cases in which the steel required for the intended use
6 is not melted and poured in the United States.

7 (b) NATIONAL SECURITY EXCEPTION.—Subsection
8 (a) shall not apply with respect to a purchase that the
9 Secretary of Defense determines is necessary for national
10 security purposes.
