## A BILL

To suspend temporarily the duty on bags for certain toys.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. TEMPORARY SUSPENSION OF DUTY.**

4       (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of  
5       the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is  
6       amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following  
7       new heading:

“	9902.42.01	Bags (provided for in subheading 4202.92.45) intended for transporting, storing, or protecting dolls, toys, and other articles provided for in headings 9502–9504, inclusive, imported and sold with such articles therein ...	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/2005	”.

1           (b) **EFFECTIVE DATE.**—The amendment made by  
2 subsection (a) applies to articles entered, or withdrawn  
3 from warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day  
4 after the date of enactment of this Act.
