## A BILL

To provide for the elimination of duty on Thiophanate-  
Methyl.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. ELIMINATION OF DUTY ON THIOPHANATE-**  
4       **METHYL.**

5       (a) IN GENERAL.—Chapter 29 of the Harmonized  
6       Tariff Schedule of the United States is amended by insert-  
7       ing in numerical sequence the following new subheading,  
8       with the article description having the same degree of in-  
9       dentation as the article description for subheading  
10      2930.10.00:

“ | 2930.10.10 | Thiophanate-Methyl (CAS No. | Free | | 25% | ”.

1 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by  
2 subsection (a) applies with respect to goods entered, or  
3 withdrawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after  
4 the 15th day after the date of the enactment of this Act.
