A BILL

To extend the temporary suspension of duty on bromine-containing compounds.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF EXISTING DUTY SUSPENSIONS.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of
5 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is
6 amended in the effective period column of headings
7 9902.28.08, 9902.28.09, and 9902.28.10 by striking the
8 date contained therein and inserting “12/31/2005”.

9 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by
10 subsection (a) shall apply with respect to goods entered,

1 or withdrawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after
2 the date that is 15 days after the date of the enactment
3 of this Act.
