## A BILL

To suspend temporarily the duty on certain rubber riding boots.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SUSPENSION OF DUTY ON CERTAIN RUBBER**  
4 **RIDING BOOTS.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of  
6 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is  
7 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following  
8 new heading:

“	9902.64.01	Tall boots with soles and uppers of rubber, that extend above the calf and below the knee, are suitable for horseback riding, and have a spur rest on the heel counter (provided for in subheading 6401.92.90) .....	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/2005	”.

1           (b) **EFFECTIVE DATE.**—The amendment made by  
2 subsection (a) applies to articles entered, or withdrawn  
3 from warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day  
4 after the date of the enactment of this Act.
