## A BILL

To extend temporary suspension of duty with respect to Ethofumesate.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. ETHOFUMESATE.**

4       (a) **IN GENERAL.**—Subheading 9902.31.12 of the  
5 Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is  
6 amended by striking “12/31/2001” and inserting “12/31/  
7 2005”.

8       (b) **EFFECTIVE DATE.**—The amendment made by  
9 this section shall apply to articles described in subheading  
10 9902.31.12 of the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the

- 1 United States that are entered, or withdrawn from ware-
- 2 house for consumption, after December 31, 2001.
