## A BILL

To suspend temporarily the duty on certain parts of gearing,  
gear boxes, and other speed changers.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. CERTAIN PARTS OF GEARING, GEAR BOXES,**

4                       **AND OTHER SPEED CHANGERS.**

5       (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of  
6 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is  
7 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following  
8 new heading:

“	9902.84.84	Parts of gearing, gear boxes, and other speed changers (provided for in sub-heading 8483.90.50) .....	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/2005	”.

1           (b) **EFFECTIVE DATE.**—The amendment made by  
2 subsection (a) applies with respect to goods entered, or  
3 withdrawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after  
4 the 15th day after the date of the enactment of this Act.
