## A BILL

To suspend temporarily the duty on certain engine parts.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. CERTAIN ENGINE PARTS.**

4       (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of  
5       the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is  
6       amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following  
7       new heading:

“	9902.84.11	Parts suitable for use solely or principally with the engines of heading 8407 or 8408, for vehicles of subheading 8701.20, or heading 8702, 8703, or 8704, other than connecting rods (provided for in subheading 8409.99.91) .....	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/2005	”.

1           (b) **EFFECTIVE DATE.**—The amendment made by  
2 subsection (a) applies with respect to goods entered, or  
3 withdrawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after  
4 the 15th day after the date of the enactment of this Act.
