## A BILL

To suspend temporarily the duty on trifluralin.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. TRIFLURALIN.**

4       (a) IN GENERAL.—Heading 9902.29.02 of the Har-  
5       monized Tariff Schedule of the United States (relating to  
6       trifluralin) is amended—

7               (1) by striking “3.3%” and inserting “Free”;

8       and

9               (2) by striking “12/31/2003” and inserting  
10       “12/31/2005”.

11       (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by  
12       subsection (a) applies with respect to goods entered, or

- 1 withdrawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after
- 2 the 15th day after the date of the enactment of this Act.
