## A BILL

To extend the suspension of duty on Meta-chlorobenzaldehyde.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. META-CHLOROBENZALDEHYDE.**

4 (a) **IN GENERAL.**—Heading 9902.28.17 of the Har-  
5 monized Tariff Schedule of the United States is amended  
6 by striking the date in the effective period column and  
7 inserting “12/31/2006”.

8 (b) **EFFECTIVE DATE.**—The amendment made by  
9 subsection (a) applies with respect to goods entered, or

- 1 withdrawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after
- 2 the 15th day after the date of the enactment of this Act.
