## A BILL

To amend the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971 to prohibit nonparty multicandidate political committee contributions in elections for Federal office.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PROHIBITION OF CONTRIBUTIONS BY**  
4 **NONPARTY MULTICANDIDATE POLITICAL**  
5 **COMMITTEES IN ELECTIONS FOR FEDERAL**  
6 **OFFICE.**

7 Section 315 of the Federal Election Campaign Act  
8 of 1971 (2 U.S.C. 441a) is amended by adding at the end  
9 the following new subsection:

1       “(i)(1) Notwithstanding any other provision of this  
2 Act, no nonparty multicandidate political committee may  
3 make any contribution to a candidate for Federal office.

4       “(2) As used in this subsection, the term ‘multi-  
5 candidate political committee’ has the meaning given that  
6 term in subsection (a)(4).”.
